ALAMEDA COUNTY CHILDREN'S SART GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- Alameda County service providers have a responsibility to ensure that screening, assessment, referral and treatment of young children at risk for developmental challenges are provided in a nurturing fashion which respects the cultural, ethnic and linguistic needs of our residents and builds on family strengths
- 2. Services for young children in our county should be easily accessible with many points of entry and "no wrong door"
- Children have a right to appropriate services to help support their development regardless of insurance coverage, ability to pay, or immigration status
- 4. Families should be supported through all steps of the process in obtaining necessary services to enhance their child's development (screening, assessment, referral and treatment)
- 5. All SART services must be grounded in best practices and meet quality standards
- 6. Principles of equity and social justice must be considered when developing priorities for whom will have access to any new services developed
