HOW CAN I HELP MY CHILD GET READY FOR SCHOOL?

BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS

- Look at or read books with your child everyday
- Have your child practice getting dressed, using the bathroom, and washing his/her hands
- Help your child learn to listen, follow directions and take turns
- Teach your child to recognize some of the letters in his/her name
- Visit the school with your child and talk about what you see
- Let your child know you are excited about Kindergarten

WHEN SCHOOL STARTS

- Make sure your child gets enough sleep, eats a healthy breakfast and is dressed for the weather
- Talk with the teacher often, and ask how you can help your child learn at home
- Ask the teacher how to get involved at school. Go to parent conferences and meetings

WHAT DO I NEED TO REGISTER MY CHILD?

Kindergarten registration generally takes place during the Winter / Spring before your child will start elementary school

To register your child for Kindergarten, make sure you have the following ready:

1. Proof of your child's birth certificate
2. Two or three documents proving address of where your child lives, for example:
 - Rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, CA Identification Card, military ID, letter from Social Services Agency, letter from landlord
 - If you do not have a permanent residence, your child is still eligible for Kindergarten. Contact your local school district for information
3. Proof of Child Health Exam on, or after, March 2 of Kindergarten year
4. Proof of your child's immunizations/shots (yellow card)
5. Some districts also require your child to have a dental exam

Contact your local school district for any additional requirements, or with questions.
